## Parents Corner- Internet Safety

Internet safety is a growing concern for every parent, regardless how old your child gets. The minute your child can go on a computer, they and you are exposed to the dangers of the information highway.

Signs your child might be at risk on line-

- 1- Your child spends large amounts of time on-line, especially at night.*
- 2- You find pornography on your child's computer.*
- 3-Your child receives phone calls from people you don't know (sometimes long distance) from numbers you don't know.*
- 4-Your child receives mail, gifts, or packages from someone you don't know.*
- 5- Your child turns off the computer monitor off or changes the screen when you enter the room.*
- 6- Your child is seems withdrawn from the family.*
